At Lumens, we also conduct various exhibitions for Science where students showcase the knowledge they have learnt in the classroom. The school has been a strong believer in the physical development of the child and hence has ensured that every child is able to pick a sport of their interest by offering a plethora of options ranging from Skating, Karate, Basketball, Football, Gymnastics etc. We have also taken part in District and State Level Chess competitions and have secured a rank in the same.
