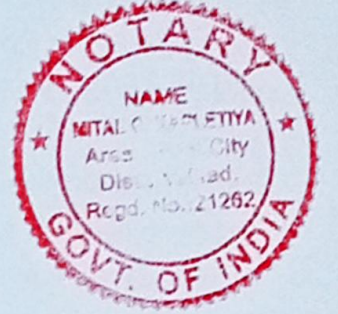

Subject: Matter of accreditation of private primary school (non-granted).

Reference : (1) Proposal submitted by your Mandal / Trust from 22/01/15.  
(2) Investigation inspection report received by the inquiry committee.

In connection with the above subject, it is to be mentioned that, according to the proposal received from your board/trust regarding the commencement of Lumens School, Chandor, Ta. Vapi (Non Granted English Medium) from June-15, the inspection committee visited the school site proposed by your trust/board. Subject to the provisions of Gujarat Right to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2012 made under the Right to Free and Compulsory Education of Children Act, 2009 as per the report submitted from the relevant letter from the inspection, hence, the following conditions from June 2015 to Std-1 to 5 (English medium) Recognition certificate is given to the manager of Lumens School, Chandor, Ta. Vapi, Dist. Valsad in Valsad district (city).

### Conditions :


1. A given accreditation is not extensible and does not imply in any way an obligation to accredit/affiliate above Std. 8.



2. The Right to Free and Compulsory Education of Children Act, 2009 (35th of 2009). The provisions of Gujarat Right to Free and Compulsory Education Rules 2012, guidelines issued by Government of India and State Government and any instructions, orders or government resolutions shall be binding on the school.
3. The school should admit children from the weaker sections and disadvantaged groups in the vicinity, up to 25% of that standard number in standard 1, including pre-primary classes, and provide free and compulsory early education till its completion.
4. Capitation (per capita) fees are prohibited and therefore; The trust, congregation or school should not charge for any capitation fees or other donations or items in exchange for such fees.
5. The school should not in any way adopt any screening test or procedure of the child or his or her parents or guardians for admission purposes.
6. The school should not refuse admission to a child for lack of proof of age or on the basis of religion, caste, punch or creed, place of birth or any of them.
7. The school should ensure that;
  - 1) No admitted child shall be detained or expelled from any standard till the completion of elementary education in the school.
  - 2) No child is subject to physical punishment or mental abuse.
  - 3) No child should be required to pass any board examination until the completion of elementary education.
  - 4) Every child who completes elementary education should be awarded a certificate as prescribed under Rule 30.
  - 5) Admission / inclusion of students with disabilities or special needs as per the provisions of the Act.
  - 6) A. Teachers are recruited by the National Council of Teachers Education and by the State Government or by an authority authorized under sub-section (1) of section 23 of the Act to have and fulfill the minimum qualifications prescribed.



- B. Government Resolution No.: PRE-1110-223-K dated April 27, 2012 of the Department of Education; Also see to it that the required qualifications are met,
  - C. Existing teachers who do not have minimum qualifications at the commencement of the Act shall attain such minimum qualification within a period of 5 years from the commencement of the Act.
  - D. Government Resolution No.: PRE-1110-223-K dated April 27, 2012 of the Department of Education; After the publication of, any new teacher who has been recruited will be required to pass the Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) prescribed for the respective (group) group.
- 7) If the school has a student-teacher ratio as prescribed in the Schedule to the Act or, as the case may be, the school has less than 300 square feet of classrooms, the proportion fixed from clause (d) of sub-rule (1) of Rule-13 whichever is less Teachers should be recruited as per the requirement specified in the schedule.
  - 8) The rules and regulations made by the state government regulating the salaries and allowances payable to teachers and the terms and conditions of their service should be applied,
  - 9) The teacher shall perform his duties as specified under sub-section (1) of section 24 of the Act,
  - 10) Teachers should not engage themselves in private education activities,
  - 11) A transparent and fair admission process should be followed in compliances with the guidelines and orders issued by the Central Government or the State Government or the Director.

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- 12) Any regulations, orders, instructions, or guidelines issued from time to time by the State Government or the Director of Primary Education in respect of fees collected from students should be strictly followed.
  8. The school provides education according to the curriculum prepared on the basis of the curriculum formulated by the appropriate authority.
  9. The school should admit students in proportion to the facilities available in the school as decided in section 19 of the Act.
  10. The school should maintain the school standards and norms as specified in Section 19 of the Act and specifically Rule 13 of the Act relating to the provision of any information, maintenance of the school website and filling up of accurate and reliable DISE District Information System for Education Data every year. All conditions must be met.
  11. No unauthorized classes should be conducted inside the school premises or outside the school under the same name.
  12. School buildings or other constructions or grounds should be used for education and skill development purposes only.
  13. The school is to be run by a congregation registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860 (21<sup>st</sup> of 1860) or by a public trust formed under any law in force at the time.
  14. The school is not run for the benefit of any individual, group or association of individuals or any individuals.
  15. The chartered accountant should have the accounts audited and certified and the proper accounts should be prepared as per the rules. A copy of the audited report should be sent to the competent authority every year.
  16. The School shall provide periodic report and information to the Director and the competent authority and comply with the orders issued by the State Government/Local Authority to fulfill the condition of accreditation to continue the school or to rectify the deficiencies in the functioning of the school.



- 17) The congregation, if any, should be registered and refreshed.
- 18) Qualified teachers as prescribed by the Government shall be appointed.
- 19) Authorized government officials and employees of your school will be able to visit the school. The information, forms, files required by them will have to be submitted for inspection.
- 20) If your school is recognized as a non-granted school, you will have to collect fees from the students as per the rules and regulations of the Government from time to time.
21. This approval is granted as non-granted. So that the school / board / trust will not ask for any kind of grant from the government for the standard class given with the above approval.

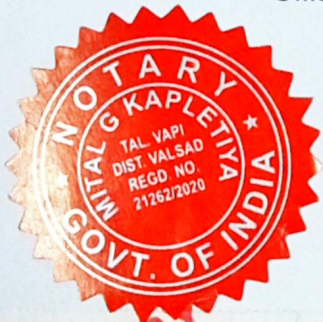
