## Reality of Coaching Classes

- Coaching centres trap students by offering minimum 30% discount on test. Test is purposely kept very tough. Parents are told that their child has done well and hence he/she is offered discount while the child is made to feel that he/she has lot to learn. Parents are told to pay within a couple of days to avail discount.
- Fees for two years are collected over first four months, 1<sup>st</sup> Month 50%, 2<sup>nd</sup> month-25% and so on. Once fees are collected, they are non-refundable.
- Until the fees are collected, picture is very rosy. Students are told that they need to come only for 3 days a week and very simple topics are covered. Once fees come in, number of days increase and syllabus is rushed through and students cannot cope up.
- They indulge in false marketing, advertising performance of students who are not from their centres.



• **Myth**: Coaching centers have good study material.

• **Reality:** All coaching centers use same study material with little and insignificant difference. It is all available openly.

• All coaching centers provide a lot of books, test series and notes but too much material can be overwhelming, leading stress and failure rather than improvement.



- **Myth**: Coaching centers provide good competition
- **Reality:** Competition is unreal and often ends up demotivating students.

Competition is not real. Exams at coaching institutes are given on benches with 3 to 4 students on a bench where children are allowed to copy. Online exams have earlier students logged in and hence is easier to copy. Parents remain in dark until end. Sincere students feel demotivated thinking they are left behind in the race.

Students who keep improving their own attempt over two years are the ones who generally score well. It is more about improving your own attempt rather than competition



- **Myth**: 12<sup>th</sup> Board exam practice and syllabus is covered by Coaching classes
- **Reality:** Students are not given any practice for board exams in coaching classes.
- 75% minimum is required in CBSE 12<sup>th</sup> boards for JEE. Current year papers were tough for students because CBSE board pattern has changed.
- Students are doing well neither in board exams, nor in JEE/NEET and hence are left with very few options.



- Myth: Coaching classes provide one to one mentorship and doubt solving classes
- **Reality:** A large percentage of children start dropping out because they can't cope up. If child doesn't attend classes, child will be called for counselling as a process but coaching pattern continues. Parent will keep getting calls from different people until they say that child is not interested.
- There is frequent rolling of teachers. Hence child gets confused.
- Children tend to wander outside the classes and parents are unaware
- There are no specific doubt solving sessions. Students have to wait for faculty after classes.



• Myth: Different brands of coaching classes have different owners

- **Reality:** Different brands often have the same set of owners and same set of investors. For e.g, one of the largest brands closed down and another of their brand is telling students that they have no relation with that brand. There is a rift between major shareholders who are looking for exit.
- They indulge in influential marketing with t-shirts, bags, etc. carrying names of the brand to make parents feel that everyone is going for the same brand.

### What is JEE?

#### • JEE Main:

- This is the first stage and serves as a qualifying exam for JEE Advanced.
- It's a computer-based test (CBT).
- It covers Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics.
- It consists of multiple-choice questions (MCQs) and numerical value questions.
- It also gives entry to NITs, IIITs and other government funded technical institutions.

#### • JEE Advanced:

- This is the second stage, and only those who qualify in JEE Main are eligible to take it.
- It's also a CBT.
- It also covers Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics, but at a more advanced level.
- It is designed to test the conceptual clarity and problem-solving abilities of the candidates.
- This exam is the only entry way to the IIT's.



• **Myth**: Career options with science stream is only limited to IIT and MBBS.

#### • Reality:

- JEE mains are applicable in all engineering courses and most other engineering colleges in India and across the world.
- NEET marks are applicable in various courses like BAMS, BHMS,BUMS, BVSC etc.

## Comparison of Question Levels – CBSE v/s JEE

#### CBSE Board Level:

Question:- A convex lens of focal length 20 cm is used to form an image of an object placed 30 cm away from it. Calculate the position and nature of the image formed.

#### • JEE Level (Extended Concept & Application-Based):

Question:- A convex lens of focal length 20 cm is placed 30 cm away from an object. A concave mirror of focal length 15 cm is placed 50 cm behind the lens. Find the final position of the image formed by the mirror.

This question extends the board syllabus concept by integrating multiple optical elements, requiring a deeper conceptual understanding and multi-step problem-solving

Syllabus is vast but entirely based on Grade 11 and 12 syllabus concepts.

- JEE exams emphasize conceptual understanding rather than rote memorization.






